CENTRAL COAST GRAND PRIX

Welcome to the 23rd Annual Central Coast Grand Prix. This program is a series of eight Junior Open Tennis Tournaments sanctioned by the SCTA. The top eight point earners in each division will be invited to participate in the season-ending Masters Tournament to be held October 10-11, 2009 in Santa Barbara.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE

- A. To participate, a player must have or purchase at tournament a current USTA card.
- B. Participants must play at least one of the designated Grand Prix Tournaments.
- C. To earn points, a player must play each tournament entered to completion without default, unless the default is caused by a tournament administration error.
- D. Players participating in the Masters Championship must play the event to completion to receive trophies/prizes.
- E. Players competing in a draw of 16 or less must play a match to win grand prix points.
- F. Defaults count as a win (for points), but byes do not as a match played.
- G. To enter a tournament, fill out a SCTA standard entry blank and mail to the tournament. Deadlines and fees are listed in this Central Coast brochure.

GRAND PRIX

The Grand Prix concept is very exciting. Participants accumulate points starting at the round of 16 and continuing until the finals. Only one tournament is required to be played, however, the greater number of tournaments played will increase the opportunity to earn points and qualify for the Masters. Points will be accumulated in singles in the boys and girls 10,12,14,16,18 and the top eight point earners will be invited to attend the Masters.

CENTRAL COAST GRAND PRIX STANDING

Each Tournament will attempt to post the current position of the players. This will permit tournament players to be aware of their current position and judge the number of tournaments they need to play to improve their position in the Central Coast Grand Prix standing. Points will also be posted on the SCTA website, www.scta.usta.com, periodically throughout the summer.

AWARDS

Assuming sufficient entries, awards will be presented to the winner and runner-up in every age division at each tournament.

RULES

USTA Rules will govern play. Participants should check in fifteen minutes before scheduled match time. The USTA Point Penalty System will be enforced during events.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Juniors may enter tournaments by using entry blanks provided by the tournament, using the SCTA Standardized Entry Blank, or entering online at www.scta.usta.com under tournaments (Tournament ID's listed on tournament schedule). Mail the completed form and (if needed) a self-addressed stamped envelope to the tournament listed in the brochure. Entries will not be accepted without the proper entry fees. If entrants fail to receive match notification three days prior to the tournament, it is the player's responsibility to contact the tournament to obtain first round match time. Most tournaments will post their information at scta.usta.com, the tournament ID # is listed for your reference.

LENGTH OF MATCHES

All matches will be best two out of three sets. A set tie-break will be used in both singles and doubles competition, when the score reaches 6-6. With proper notice or in case of inclement weather, tournaments may adjust to other USTA approved scoring formats.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Strict adherence to the Southern California Tennis Association's "Honor Code" will be required of all participants.
